The Organization

myTEAM TRIUMPH – Wisconsin Inc. is 501(c)(3) non-profit charitable athletic ride-along program created for children, teens, adults and veterans with disabilities who would normally not be able to experience an endurance event such as a road race or triathlon. myTEAM TRIUMPH – Wisconsin Inc.'s mission is to enrich the wellbeing of individuals with diverse abilities and foster life-long relationships through community athletics

myTEAM TRIUMPH is the sanctioning body for special needs participation in endurance events such as 5K's, 10K's, Cycling and Triathlon competitions. Each "team" consists of one disabled "Captain", and at least 3 athletes or "Angels". With the use of specialized running strollers, bike trailers, and boats, Angels will work together as a team to push, pull, and swim their disabled Captain from start to finish.

Founded in 2010, myTEAM TRIUMPH – Wisconsin Inc. will participate in at least 40 endurance events throughout Wisconsin and engage nearly 500 disabled Captains, 3000 Angels, and 50 volunteers. Its budget is \$400,000 and there is 1 full time Executive Director and 3 part time employees. In each of our communities, Volunteer "Crew" lead our local efforts. As a community steward, myTEAM TRIUMPH – Wisconsin Inc. will engage with local businesses, clubs, charitable organizations, and resource centers to involve an ever-growing number of individuals of varying abilities/disabilities.
