2024 Programming Impact

Inclusive Racing

In 2024, MyTeam Triumph provided race opportunities where athletes with disabilities (Captains) teamed up with ablebodied volunteers (Angels) to experience the thrill of endurance events together. These races fostered inclusion, empowerment, and lifelong friendships.

Training & Social Events

Throughout the year, we hosted group training runs, meetups, and social gatherings, giving Captains and Angels opportunities to connect, train, and prepare for race day while strengthening bonds beyond the finish line.

Youth Engagement We engaged the next generation by partnering with schools, youth programs, and community groups to educate and involve young athletes in inclusive fitness opportunities.


